- The subjunctive is used after certain expressions that contain an order or a request , demand , suggestion, a hypothetical, or a wish.
 - In most cases, the subjunctive form of a verb is usually the third-person form of the verb with the -s dropped, but the verb *be* is a special case.
 - the subjunctive does not change at all according to person (*I, you, he etc*).

- we use the subjunctive when talking about events that somebody:
 - **wants** to happen
 - **anticipates** will happen
 - **imagines** happening
-

• Eg:

- It is important that she **agree** to these terms.
- Maya insisted that the student **seek** the aid of a tutor.

- The subjunctive mood has one other use: to express wishes and hypothetical situations. Typically, this type of statement includes the word *if*.
- In this situation (be) is only past
- If I **were** a cat, I would lie in the sun all day.

The base subjunctive is typically used in **that clauses** after these structures:

1- ***suggest-verb+that...***

2- ***suggest-noun+that...***

3- ***advisable-adjective + that***

4- ***anxious-adjective + that***

1- main cause = **suggest-verb+ that ...**

*advise, ask, command, demand, desire, insist, order, prefer, propose,
recommend, request, **suggest***

eg: He suggests that You be present at the meeting.

He requested that the car park not be locked at night.

The board recommend that he join the company.

*proposal, order, demand, command, **Suggest nouns**=
suggestion, request recommendation,*

They made a	<i>suggestion</i>	<i>that</i>	we	<i>be</i>	early.
He made a	<i>proposal</i>	<i>that</i>	the company	<i>buy</i>	more land.
The president has issued an	<i>order</i>	<i>that</i>	the secretary	<i>resign</i>	next month.

*desirable, crucial, best, , **adjectives = advisable***
urgent, unthinkable, necessary, important, imperative, essential,
vital

It is	<i>advisable</i>	<i>that</i>	she		<i>rest</i>	for a week.
It was	<i>essential</i>	<i>that</i>	the army		<i>advance</i>	rapidly.
After the landing, it will be	<i>vital</i>	<i>that</i>	every soldier	not	<i>use</i>	a radio.
