Jealous /'dʒelas/ = feeling unhappy because someone has something that you wish you have . (jealous of, **not** from).

Married /'mærid/ = having a husband or a wife. (married to, not with.)
Sarah was married to a rich man.

Note: also **engaged to** (= if two people are engaged, they have agreed to marry): Ali was <u>engaged to</u> Maryam for a year before they got married.
